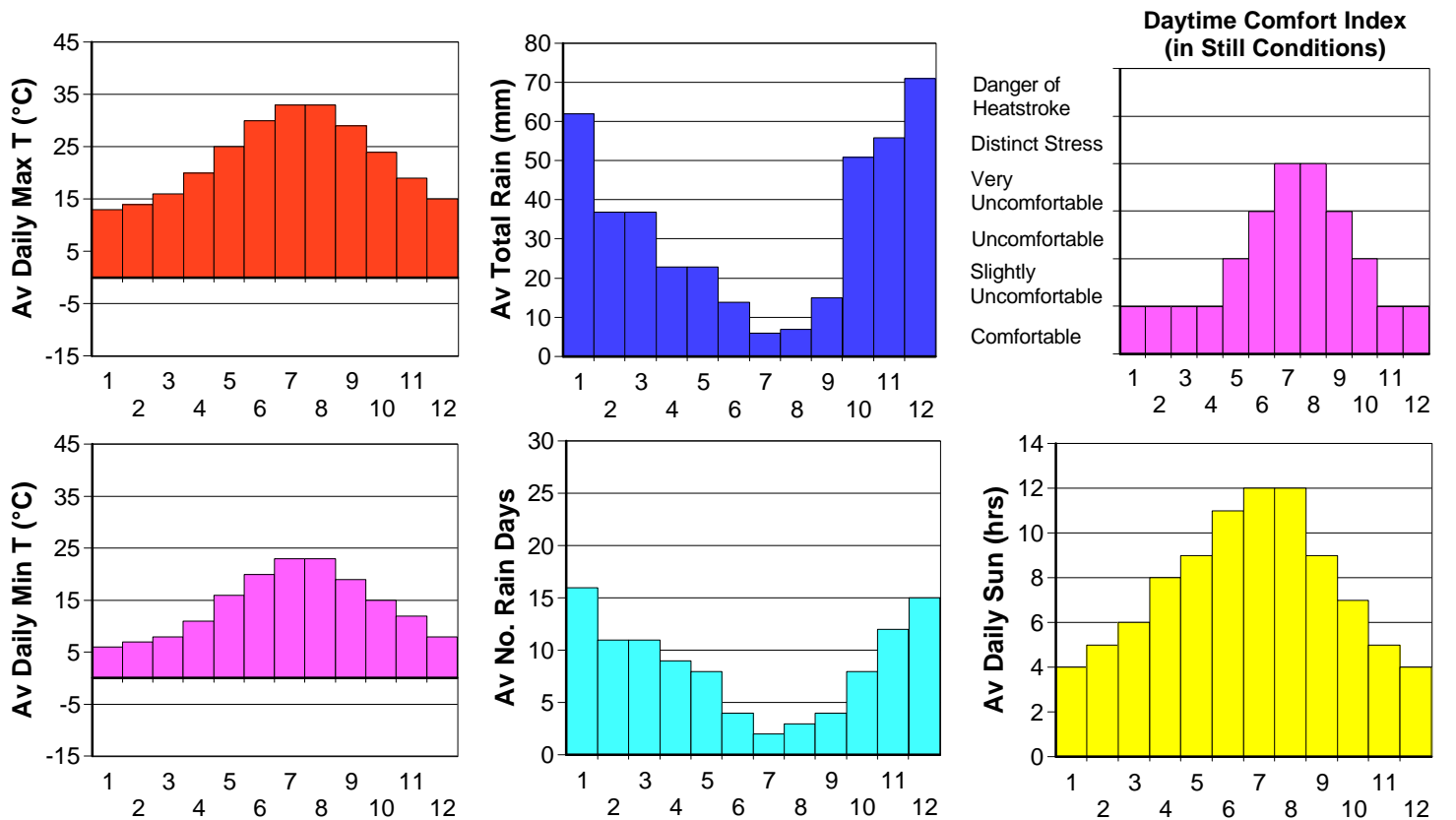

**Notes on Climate**

Athens is situated in the driest part of Greece and is most notable for its outstanding sunshine levels which average four to five hours during December and January and twelve or fourteen hours in June, July and August. The summer months are also both hot and dry, and when no breeze blows it can feel oppressive. Rainfall is confined mainly to winter and often occurs as short but heavy showers. Snowfall can also occur during the winter months but rarely lies for long.
